RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF LIVINGTON NO. 331

BYLAW NO. 01-2014

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Livingston No. 331, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Definitions

- (a) "highway" means a road within the Municipality under the direction, control and management of the Municipality that is designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles
- (b) "motor vehicle" means a vehicle propelled or driven by any means other than that by muscular power.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than 60 kilometres per hour on that portion of a public highway described as : NORTH OF NE & NW 24-34-30-W1
- 3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area
- 4. That this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing.
